# Listening to Massachusetts Students During COVID-19 — Final Toplines

## Methodology

Results for this study are based on telephone surveys conducted Nov. 18–Dec. 9, 2020, with 1,000 students aged 14 to 18 currently enrolled in Massachusetts high schools. Gallup secured permission to interview students from a parent or guardian and asked parents/guardians a limited set of questions about the household characteristics prior to talking to the selected student.

The study was conducted in English and Spanish, and includes students in private, public district and public charter schools. The survey covered landlines and cell phones and was drawn from listed landlines and a cell phone frame, which contains appended billing and ZIP code information. Although this cell phone frame does not cover all cell phone numbers, it does make it possible to target the location of the cell phone owner (such as the state of Massachusetts).

Survey results are weighted to be representative of the study population, using data from the Census Bureau's American Community Survey.

For results based on the sample of all students, the margin of sampling error is  $\pm 4.0$  percentage points at the 95% confidence level, accounting for the design effect from weighting. Margins of error for subgroups are higher. In addition to sampling error, question wording and practical difficulties in conducting surveys can introduce error or bias into the findings of public opinion polls.
